Review the Key Elements of a Memoir

- A meaningful story is told.
- The story has a plot with a beginning, middle, and end.
- The story is told in first-person.
- Chronological transitions indicate the passing of time.
- Description is used to convey mood, develop characters, create settings, and convey information.



- You are capturing a <u>significant event</u> in your life, and it has to be told as a story.
- You are using <u>vivid details</u> to keep your reader interested.
- Your reader can see your <u>story is meaningful</u> without you having to say it directly.
- Your story <u>is relatable</u> in some way to someone.
