- I. Application Qualifications
 - a. Texas resident of a Region 19 Service Center area
 - b. Applicant is employed in a Region 19 ISD as a classroom teacher
 - c. Graduate student with at least six hours toward a graduate degree in Education
 - d. Graduate student must have six to twenty-four hours remaining toward completion of graduate degree
 - e. Graduate degree plan is on file with the university
 - f. Vita form, goals statement, graduate degree plan, and unofficial transcript are required with application

- II. Application Timeline
 - a. Grant forms will be available through the Region 19 Service Center and Region 19 ISDs
 - b. Applications due between June 1, 2021—June 30, 2021
 - c. District XIX Master's Grant Committee will evaluate applications in July and will award the Master's Degree Grant in October at the District XIX TRTA Fall Conference

- III. Graduate Student Timeline
 - a. Graduate student has twelve months to complete grant which will start at the beginning of the first session the student takes classes and seeks reimbursement
 - b. Cost of fees, tuition, books, and materials may be reimbursed up to the total amount of grant (June 2021 grant will be \$1,000)
 - c. Applicant may reapply for a second grant if a 3.0 or better GPA has been maintained and nine (9) or more credits in a 12 month period have been earned
