STEM/TXTQP Teacher Resident Profile

- Participants must have a bachelor's degree or higher and a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Participants must be accepted into the ESC 19 Teacher Preparation and Certification Program.
- Participants must qualify through transcripts or the PACT exam to teach in grades 7-12 STEM certification areas or Core Subjects 4-8 (priority given to candidates that qualify for STEM fields).
- Participants must complete a one-year residency working alongside a mentor teacher in Clint ISD.
- Participants must commit to the STEM/TXTQP TPCP program for one year.
- Participants must pursue a Master of Education in Learning and Technology degree at Western Governor's University.
- Participants must serve as a secondary school math, science or computer science teacher for a minimum of 3 years at a high need school following the residency program.
