- improvement plan with the ultimate goal of meeting accountability standards. . Of the 7 schools requiring a PSP in 2018-2019, 4 have chosen to use ESC 19 as their PSP and

# **SLDS TECHNICAL CENTER**

ESC R19 Informational & Technology Services Department submitted an application to TEA to become the Technical Assistance Center for the SLDS Data Literacy and student GPS Dashboards. Region 19 was the sole recipient of an \$800,000 grant to support the development of advanced training materials surrounding the TSDS student GPS Dashboards. The professional development materials and resources created by Region 19 will become the materials used throughout the state when working with Dashboards. This is a huge accomplishment to building a strong understanding of data, its use, and participation in data-driven decision making.
