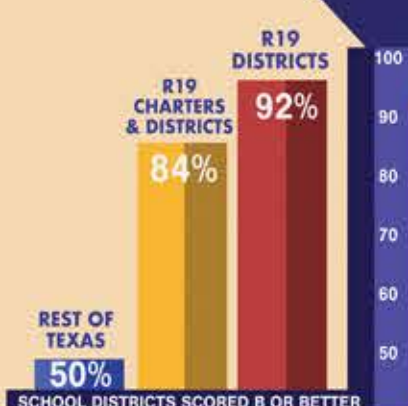


## ESC 19 2017-2018 HIGHLIGHTS

### OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE

#### TEA A-F ACCOUNTABILITY RATINGS

- 11 out of 12 ISD's received a letter grade of B or Better.
- 16 out of 19 school and charter districts received a letter grade of B or Better.
- Region 19 had the fewest number of schools identified as "Improvement Required" (only 1) as compared to the remainder of regions in the state.
- Region 19 had the fewest number of schools identified for "Comprehensive Support" (total of 7) when compared to the remainder of regions in the state.

### HEAD START

#### NON-COMPETITIVE STATUS FOR THE NEXT FIVE YEARS

- All five required Federal Monitoring Reviews resulted "No Areas of Non-Compliance."
- Exceeded the 20% Non-Federal Share required amount by \$3,638,575 for a grand total of \$11,996,975.

### SECURED GRANT GEAR UP

#### COLLEGE & CAREER FUNDING FOR SAN ELIZARIO ISD

ESC Region 19 and the Information & Instructional Technology Services Department has successfully secured GEAR UP funding for San Elizario ISD for six years. GEAR UP funds will allow for targeted services to be provided to further prepare students for college and career at the middle school and high school levels. Student, parent, and teacher support will further enhance the opportunities for post-secondary excellence for the San Elizario community.

### PSP MODEL FOR CAMPUSES

- ESC Region 19 is recognized by TEA to serve as a PSP for schools identified as needing improvement.
- The PSP role requires supporting a campus and monitoring the implementation of a targeted improvement plan with the ultimate goal of meeting accountability standards.
- Of the 7 schools requiring a PSP in 2018-2019, 4 have chosen to use ESC 19 as their PSP and assist in matching their needs to resources and support to effect change on a truncated timetable.
- ESC Region 19 results in Sierra Blanca ISD and Dell City ISD have been recognized by the Deputy Commissioner and Commissioner of TEA throughout Texas.

### SLDS TECHNICAL CENTER

ESC R19 Informational & Technology Services Department submitted an application to TEA to become the Technical Assistance Center for the SLDS Data Literacy and student GPS Dashboards. Region 19 was the sole recipient of an \$800,000 grant to support the development of advanced training materials surrounding the TSDDS student GPS Dashboards. The professional development materials and resources created by Region 19 will become the materials used throughout the state when working with Dashboards. This is a huge accomplishment to building a strong understanding of data, its use, and participation in data-driven decision making.
